Lightsview to City Go-Zone

From 23 July 2023, the 206 bus services will become a Go-Zone from Folland Avenue, Northgate via East Parkway, Lightsview into the City.

As part of my election commitment, three new buses will be commissioned resulting in a 15-minute service on weekdays from 7:30am to 7:00pm, and then half hourly from 7:00pm to midnight.

On weekends, services will operate every 30 minutes from 7:00am to midnight on Saturdays and from 8:30am to midnight on Sundays.

Andrea's Community Update

Welcome to 2023! I hope you have had a great start to the year and I look forward to working with you to make our community prosper.

Thank you to everyone who came along to my street corner meetings in 2022.

I got feedback on everything from the proposed upgrade of RM Williams Reserve to concerns with community safety. I have now planned a Community Safety Forum - see inside for invitation.

I am working on the promises I made to our community at the 2022 State Election. The Malinauskas Labor Government has already delivered \$10,000 to our local Men's Shed, and the Lightsview Go-Zone is scheduled to commence from July 2023. Funding has also been provided to Council for the construction of female changerooms at both Duncan Fraser Reserve and Blair Athol Reserve.

I have also been working with the Department for Infrastructure and Transport to gather community feedback for a traffic study of the Main North Road and Regency Road intersection. This information will help identify ways to improve traffic flow, reduce wait times for drivers, and make it safer for pedestrians.
