# HOUSING



We're addressing the housing crisis by abolishing stamp duty on new homes for eligible first home buyers - saving buyers tens of thousands of dollars while also encouraging more supply of housing.

#### Our housing boost for South Australia includes:

- Abolishing stamp duty for eligible first home buyers;
- Increasing the property value cap for the existing First Home Owner Grant from \$575,000 to \$650,000;
- Delivering the first substantial increase to public housing in a generation - building an additional 564 public homes and stopping the sale of 580 others;
- Fast tracking what will be the single largest release of residential land in the State's history – set to deliver 25,000 new blocks across the north and south.

## **COST OF LIVING**

The State Government is partnering with the Commonwealth to deliver energy rebates of \$500 for eligible households and \$650 for eligible small businesses, helping more than half a million

SA households and small businesses. Other budget highlights include a \$44 million increase to existing concessions, \$32.1 million to increase carer payments and \$57.2 million to support non-government organisations.

School cost of living measures include the \$100 discount on material and services charges for public school children for 2024 and a \$6.5 million boost to school breakfast programs.

## **HEALTH**

The 2023-24 State Budget delivers a record health investment of \$2.3 billion. To ease pressure on our hospitals, we're investing in out-of-hospital care options including virtual care services and two new hospital avoidance hubs. To reduce bed-block, more doctors, physios, pharmacists and other hospital staff will be rostered on weekends to ensure timely patient discharges. We're continuing to hire more doctors, nurses and paramedics to ensure more ambulances turn up on time.

# MINISTERIAL UPDATES

#### South Australia's Small Business Strategy 2023-2030

Small businesses in South Australia contribute \$49 billion to our economy and employ almost 40 percent of our workforce.

South Australia's Small Business Strategy will be supported by a \$14.25 million investment by the Malinauskas Labor Government, funding practical initiatives to support small businesses.

The strategy was informed by the most comprehensive and intensive engagement program with small businesses this state has ever seen.

Small business owners are now able to seek advice from a team of dedicated Business Support Officers - travelling throughout metropolitan and regional South Australia and participate in capability building programs.

#### **Residential Tenancies Act Review**

South Australia's rental laws must be updated to modernise our rental housing market. In 2022, we sought community feedback with over 5000 people completing an online survey and more than 150 organisations contributing submissions. The consultation report was released recently and outlines the findings of the review. Changes have already been made to reform our state's rental market with the Malinauskas Labor Government's A Better Housing Future commitment which included the banning of rent bidding.

Currently, a bill is being drafted utilising the feedback provided from the public for additional reforms targeting end of tenancy notices, unfair evictions and renting with pets.

# COMMUNITY WIN LIGHTSVIEW GO ZONE

The first new and improved 206 bus service departed from Folland Avenue on 24 July 2023. This service will greatly benefit residents from Lightsview and Northgate who have been requesting this service for years. The Malinauskas Labor Government has committed \$8.7 million over five years to introduce this bus service. I am pleased to deliver on my election commitment to ensure our community has access to better transport services.

The three new buses ordered to meet the increased vehicle requirements will be electric hybrid rigid buses. Buses rotate across the fleet, so patrons shouldn't be surprised to see diesel buses on any route (including the Lightsview Go Zone) as they are gradually phased out.

As a step towards a cleaner, greener, zero-emission future for public transport in South Australia, the Malinauskas Labor Government took delivery of the last new diesel rigid bus in 2022. All new rigid bus orders are now electric hybrid or fully electric vehicles.

As well as eliminating noise and fuel-based pollution, electric buses offer passengers more space, better comfort and accessibility.
